THE PANDEMIC IS NOT OVER – so Sunshine Cathedral will continue to ask that you reserve your seat at Sunshinecathedral.org if you wish to worship onsite, and we insist that you wear a mask at all times while you are here. According to the latest CDC recommendations, small groups of vaccinated people can gather unmasked, but mixed, public gatherings (where many may yet be unvaccinated) should continue to follow established protocols (safe distancing, hand washing, and mask wearing). For worship at Sunshine Cathedral, we will continue to follow these prudent recommendations until further notice.

WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH – In the 1970s Billie Jean King fought for equal treatment of women in sports. Since the 1980s she has been an LGBTQ icon. Today she is a part owner of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Several years ago her being outed was called one of the three most important moments in LGBTQ sports history. King was inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame in 1987. King is considered one of the greatest tennis players in history. She won 12 women's Grand Slam titles.

and the Wimbledon title six times. She added 27 doubles and mixed-doubles Grand Slam titles, making her the third-most decorated player in Grand Slam history.

Since then she has pushed for further equality for LGBTQ people, women and various under-served communities. In 2009 she was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom. In 2014 President Barack Obama named her to his Olympic delegation in an attempt to open international eyes to the presence and success of LGBTQ athletes.

ECUMENISM - Sunshine Cathedral is affiliated with the International Council of Community Churches (which is a member of the World and National Councils of Churches), Metropolitan Community Churches, the Global Justice Institute (at MCC New York), the Divine Science Federation (of which our senior minister is president), and BOLD Justice (a Broward County network of churches working together with government and community leaders for a kinder and more just life for all in our county). In relationship and partnership we can achieve so much.

HOUT TV - Another ministry partner for Sunshine Cathedral is Happening Out Television Network, a new (less than 3 years old) streaming network that produces LGBTQ+themed news and social programming, and they also produce the streaming services of Sunshine Cathedral. HOUT is now housed on the campus of Sunshine Cathedral.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

March 14: Fannie Lou Hamer (1917-1977)—Prophet of freedom. Raised in a family of sharecroppers in rural Mississippi, Hamer rose up as a prophet to challenge the oppression of segregation and poverty. At the age of 45 she attended a civil rights rally and committed herself to the freedom movement. On several occasions she was

arrested and beaten, but despite the dogs, fire hoses, clubs, and bombs she drew on her deep faith and vision of justice to challenge the powers of oppression. She died of breast cancer.

March 15: St. Longinus – Longinus is the name tradition gives to the unnamed Roman soldier who pierced Jesus' sided with a spear during the Crucifixion. Tradition also holds that he became a follower of the way of Jesus.

March 16: Grant Lynn Ford (1939 – 2019) – Pentecostal Minister, Independent Catholic Bishop, Metropolitan Community Churches (MCC) Pastor, and Divine Science Minister. Bishop Ford had a unique talent for blending high church liturgy, charismatic enthusiasm, and New Thought teaching into a unified experience of celebration. He pastored the Sunshine Cathedral in Fort Lauderdale 22 years before retiring. He was succeeded by his handpicked replacement, Rev. Dr. Durrell Watkins, another religious pluralist/liturgist/New Thought practitioner. Grant was a graduate of a Pentecostal bible college and a lifemember of the International New Thought Alliance and held an honorary doctorate from Light University (later known as The Samaritan Institute). The Sunshine Cathedral's prayer garden is named for him: The Grant Lynn Ford Prayer Garden.

March 17: St. Patrick (389-461)—Bishop and missionary of Ireland. He was born into a Christian family in late Roman Britain. At 16 he was captured by Irish raiders and taken into slavery, where his only consolation was his Christian faith. Years later he escaped and returned to England, where he eventually became a Bishop. He felt called back to Ireland where he was able to spread the Christian faith.

March 19: St. Joseph—Little is known about Joseph, apart from the Nativity stories in Matthew and Luke. He is pictured as a person of deep faith, open to mystical experiences, who had great compassion. As a carpenter he is known as the patron saint of working folk. His family home was said to be in Nazareth.
