To the Congregation of Sunshine Cathedral:

Today, the Fort Lauderdale and greater Broward County community gathers to celebrate the 50th anniversary of Sunshine Cathedral, the oldest established LGBTQ+ organization in the county, and "the world's largest progressive queer church."

Organized in 1971 and originally named Church of the Holy Spirit Metropolitan Community Church, the congregation was founded by LGBTQ+ people with an affirming and primary outreach to the LGBTQ+ community, their friends, and allies.



Many of the LGBTQ+ organizations in Broward County can attest to having a present or past connection with the cathedral, including various progressive and justice seeking religious organizations such as Metropolitan Community Churches, the Center for Progressive Christianity, the International New Thought Alliance, the International Council of Community Churches, the Divine Science Federation International, the Global Justice Institute, and BOLD Justice.

Under the leadership of the Reverend Elder John Gill, the Right Reverend Grant Lynn Ford and the Reverend Doctor Durrell Watkins, the only three individuals to serve as senior pastor of Sunshine Cathedral in the last 44 of its 50-year history, the church has long advocated and worked for marriage equality, women's rights, HIV prevention, Transgender rights, and acknowledgment that "all people have sacred value and are made in the divine image."

Through local programs and live-streaming broadcasts, Sunshine Cathedral now engages a global congregation of over 30,000 people and serves over five million individuals annually.

This church, its leaders, and its members have been a beacon of light in South Florida since its founding 50 years ago and I am proud to help declare Sunday, October 3, 2021 as Sunshine Cathedral Day in the city of Fort Lauderdale.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

October 17: Florence Scovel Shinn (1871 – 1940)

– An actor, illustrator, and writer. She wrote mainly about metaphysical spirituality. She believed that "Owing to the vibratory power of words, whatever [one] voices, [one] begins to attract." Louise Hay once acknowledged Shinn as one of her early spiritual influences.

October 18: St. Luke the Evangelist

—Luke was the only writer to attempt to tell the story of not only the life of Jesus (the Gospel of Luke), but the founding of the early Church (the book of Acts). He was a Gentile who never met Jesus, but tradition says he was a physician and a later companion of Paul. St. Luke is patron of physicians and artists.

October 20: Bro. Wayne Teasdale (1945 – 2004)

- a Catholic monk best known as a proponent of mutual understanding between the world's religions, for an interfaith dialogue which he termed "interspirituality". He was also an active campaigner on issues of social justice.

October 22: Ursula Gestefeld (1845 – 1921)

— a student of Mary Baker Eddy, she and Eddy had a falling out and Gestefeld became an independent teacher of spiritual healing. She wrote a treatment for releasing the past; it included these words: "I have no sorrow, no regrets; I am filled with praise and rejoicing...Nothing that anyone can say of me can hurt me or turn me aside. I press forward steadily with no thought of blame for them who judge me according to the dead past...All malice, hatred, and enmity are left with the past. I bow only to love; I feel only love, for every human being. I begin to know God, for God is Love."

Paul Tillich (1886-1965)

– 20th century theologian who blended contemporary biblical scholarship, existential philosophy, ontology (study of being), and psychological insights to articulate a profound understanding of God. He denied the existence of the God in whom he deeply believed; that is, he denied God was a being (even a supreme one) but instead was the ground of being. God does not exist; rather, God IS existence. God is the power to be. Theological language and symbols, for Tillich, were symbolic.





Rev. Ted Callaway (1972 – 1973) Rev. Don Hoffman (1973 – 1974) Rev. Peter Wilson (1974 – 1975) from 1975 – 1976 the congregation was lay led

Rev. Elder John Gill (1976 - 1986)

The Reverend Elder John Gill earned a bachelor's degree from Franklin & Marshall College and a Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary. His background was Presbyterian and he was ordained in Metropolitan Community Churches in 1972. In addition to pastoring in Fort Lauderdale, John also served as a founding pastor in Atlanta, and as a pastor in Houston, Sarasota, and Phoenix. He was Church of the Holy Spirit's (now known as Sunshine Cathedral) first long term pastor.



Rt. Rev. Grant Lynn Ford (1986 - 2007)

The Right Reverend Grant Lynn Ford was a graduate of Eugene Bible College (now known as New Hope Christian College). He was later awarded an honorary doctorate from Light University (now known as The Samaritan Institute). He was ordained a Pentecostal minister and served as a music minister in an Assembly of God church. He was consecrated a bishop in the Independent Catholic tradition and served as the Abbot of the Poor Servants of Jesus community in Chicago. He became an MCC minister and pastored a Metropolitan Community Church in Illinois before coming to this church. He was the pastor of Sunshine Cathedral for 22 years and was ordained a Divine Science minister the year before he died. He was a life member of the International New Thought Alliance. The Cathedral's Grant Lynn Ford Prayer Garden is named for him and his cremains are housed in Sunshine Cathedral's Memorial Chapel.



Rev. Dr. Durrell Watkins (2007 -)

The Reverend Doctor Durrell Watkins, our current senior minister, holds a B.A. from Henderson State University, an M.A. from Goddard College, a Master of Divinity degree from Union Theological Seminary (NYC), and a Doctor of Ministry degree from the Episcopal Divinity School. He is an ordained Metropolitan Community Churches minister and also an ordained Divine Science Minister. He has standing in the International Council of Community Churches.
