We don't expect problems but we do want you to be assured that we are prepared as we can be. We are committed to keeping Sunshine Cathedral Square a safe space for all.

SUNSHINE CATHEDRAL CHOIR - When will it return? The short answer is, we don't really know. The newest goal is Autumn. This will be the 2nd attempt to fully bring back the choir. If there are 14 or more people interested in rehearsing and singing weekly (and year-round), and if there are no new waves of COVID infections, then it can certainly happen.

The choir was disbanded in Pandemic (close singing is still not recommended and concerts are still being canceled as performers test positive for the coronavirus) and after 2 and a half years on hiatus, it will take time and effort to return to the rhythm of weekly rehearsals and singing every Sunday. While the choir has been out, choir members have experienced work changes, address changes, relationship changes, health changes, etc. and, therefore, not all will be able to return. The "old choir" may be gone, but a "new choir" (to include as many members of the "old choir" as wish to be in it) is possible. This will also be an opportunity for new people to get involved in the music ministry.

We wish to express continued gratitude to our Music Ministry Co-Leaders (Sara & Barbara) for doing an excellent job and many thanks to the currently configured Music Staff for their continued support of the music program and the overall ministry of Sunshine Cathedral.

Change was forced upon us, and the past cannot be recaptured, but something new and amazing can emerge and we are excited for the opportunity. We have amazing professional musicians (vocalists & instrumentalists) producing concert quality music every week, and when we can add a committed, volunteer choir to that, the level of excellence will rise even higher. When the call to return to rehearsals is made, we hope that seasoned choir members and NEW folk as well will consider adding their voices to our Sunshine Cathedral Music Ministry.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

July 11: Agnes Galer (1860-1939)—ordained a Divine Science minister by New Thought pioneer Nona Brooks (c. 1907) and established a church in Seattle. Galer is known for being the minister who ordained Ernest Holmes (Holmes was a Divine Science minister before starting the Religious Science movement).

July 12: H. Emilie Cady (1848 – 1941) – author of spiritual texts, including Lessons in Truth, one of the most widely read books in New Thought spirituality. She was a homeopathic physician. In one of her books she declared, "I AM'...is God's name...I AM cannot be weary, or faint, or powerless; for I AM is all-life, all-power, All-Good...'I AM' spoken upward, toward the good, the true, is sure to out-picture in visible good, in success, in happiness."

July 13: Frida Kahlo (July 6, 1907 – July 13, 1954) - bisexual Mexican painter. She is known for her self-portraits.

July 14: Kathleen Besly (1858 – 1946) – Divine Science minister who wrote the classic, The Divine Art of Living, in which she writes, "We cannot fear anything or anybody if we have the full realization that God is everywhere, that God is Love and that Love is the great power of life."

Sally Miller Gearhart (April 15, 1931 – July 14, 2021) - LGBTQ-rights activist (with Harvey Milk) and first "out" lesbian to receive a U.S. tenure-track faculty position (San Francisco State University 1973).

July 16: Our Lady of Mount Carmel - Mary is said to have given the Scapular to an early Carmelite, Saint Simon Stock.
