VANDALISM AT SUNSHINE CATHEDRAL SQUARE?

- Last Monday, we found posterboards at Sunshine Cathedral Square with conspiracy theories and misinformation written all over them as well as homophobic, antisemitic, racist, anti-masking and antivax rhetoric. The incident was reported to the police. Other than a single email (which was also shared with the authorities), there has been no further incident. Property was not damaged. Some press reports got some of the details wrong (for instance, one report "defined" Sunshine Cathedral Square as our courtyard; the "Square" is the entire property, formerly referred to as our "campus"). The language on the posters was ugly and hateful, but again, the proper authorities are involved, no physical damage was done, and there have been no further incidents. Sadly, we live in a time of increased bigotry which is why Sunshine Cathedral must remain committed to a message of justice-love and compassionate community building.

LIVE BROADCAST DRIVE - One of the most important things Sunshine Cathedral has done in recent years is to professionally stream our worship services and other events. In partnership with Happening Out Television Network, our Sunday services can now be seen on Facebook, YouTube, Amazon Fire, Apple TV, Google TV, and Roku. This has taken a big investment of time, creativity, and financial resources and the payoff has been that during pandemic we never missed a service and those who experience our services multiplied exponentially. In 2020 Five Million people experienced Sunshine Cathedral, and in 2021 that number grew to 6 Million. People all over the world worship with us every week. Lives have been touched and changed, and people who have never been to Fort Lauderdale now depend on the encouragement and joy that our ministry offers. It's important and we are thrilled by the result.

In July, we are asking those who can and who appreciate what the broadcast ministry is achieving to make a special donation for this ministry. In addition to your regular giving, a gift of any size can help us continue to reach people all over the world with the progressive, positive, practical message that has enriched and empowered so many already. Our leadership has had active shooter training, and our EMS and law enforcement respond quickly when needed. We are always watching for signs of potential danger. If you see something, please say something immediately to one of our key staff leaders, Rev Dr Robert, Rev Dr Anne Atwell, Rev Kevin Tisdol, Darren Loli, or Peggy Brereton. We don't expect problems but we do want you to be assured that we are prepared as we can be. We are committed to keeping Sunshine Cathedral Square a safe space for all.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

July 24: Max Ballard (1914 – 1998) – youngest person to be ordained by Nona Brooks. Ballard pioneered Divine Science churches in Colorado and Missouri and led a church in D.C. until his demise.

July 25: Apostle James the Greater (d. 44) – one of Jesus' apostles.

St. Christopher (d. 251) - Patron of travelers. a Canaanite convert and a "giant" (7.5 feet tall), the legend of Christopher says he used his size to help pilgrims cross a dangerous river. One day he carried a toddler who identified himself to Christopher as Jesus (and then disappeared). Christopher was eventually martyred for his faith. "Christopher" means "Christ bearer."

July 26: St. Anne (50 BCE-12 CE) - According to Christian and Muslim traditions, Anne was the mother of Mary and grandmother of Jesus.

July 28: Frederick J. Eikerenkoetter II "Rev. Ike" (1935 – 2009) – a prosperity preacher who taught that health, wealth, good luck, harmonious relationships, and protection from adversaries could all be achieved and experienced by those who practiced his system of metaphysics. His seminary taught the "Science of Living" and his business institute was the home of "Thinkonomics." His church was a large, remodeled theatre in Washington Heights (NYC) and he believed that combining affirmative prayer with generous giving could result in an empowered, joyous, and even opulent life. Rev. Ike taught, "Acknowledge the God in you and ask for guidance" and "Your mind will work what seems like miracles to accomplish the good purpose you give it." He used such affirmations as "Nothing is too good for me" and "Good health is my divine right." He liked the bible verse, "According to your faith shall it be done to you." He called his teaching "mind power", "selfawareness", and "self-image psychology."

July 29: William Wilberforce (1759-1833) — Abolitionist. The life of Wilberforce proved that a politician can also be moral and heroic. Born to a wealthy and influential family, he experienced an evangelical conversion shortly after entering Parliament, where he worked for overseas missions and education. As a member of the House of Commons he supported political and social reforms, most especially his long and persistent fight against slavery and the slave-trade. Slavery was finally abolished in the British empire just weeks before his death. Seven hundred thousand slaves were freed. He was buried in Westminster Abbey as a national hero.

July 30: Mary, Martha, and Lazarus of Bethany-Jesus' family of choice. The stories of this household from Bethany (a village right outside Jerusalem) are found in the gospels of Luke and John. They are portrayed as close friends and disciples of Jesus, and are remembered for their hospitality. Martha has come to symbolize the active response to faith, those who get things done, and Mary that of the contemplative. When Lazarus died, Jesus stood at his grave and openly wept. While they are described as brothers and sisters, it has been suggested that Mary and Martha may have actually been a couple who called each other 'sisters' in order to pass in society. They are important for modern gay and lesbian people of faith because they represent Jesus' family of choice ---two unmarried women, and an unmarried man. Like many of us today, Jesus defined his family by intentional covenant, rather than biological or legal relatedness.
