SAINTS OF THE WEEK

August 14: St. Maximilian Kolbe (1894-1941)—Polish Franciscan priest and martyr. "Father Max" was a scholar, mystic, and missionary who demonstrated compassionate acceptance for all people, from Jewish prisoners at Auschwitz to the Buddhists and Shinto he worked with in Japan. Arrested by the Gestapo, he spent his time in the death camps comforting others and confronting evil with love. He went so far as to offer his own life to save a Jewish escapee. Sent into an underground bunker to starve to death, after two weeks he was finally executed.

Jonathan Daniels, Martyr (1939-1965) - reared in a Congregationalist home, Daniels became Episcopalian and was a seminarian at the time of his death. A graduate of the Virginia Military Institute, he briefly attended Harvard (studying literature) and then enrolled at the Episcopal Theological School. Answering Dr. King's call to activism, Daniels went to Alabama to tutor children and help enroll African American voters. On Aug. 14, 1965 Daniels and 28 other protesters were arrested and held without bail in a jail without air conditioning for 6 days. When they were released (without being offered transportation), they walked to a nearby store to get a cold beverage. Tom Coleman (a volunteer deputy) threatened the group and aimed a shotgun at 17 year old Ruby Sales. When Coleman fired the gun. Daniels stepped in the way and took the full blast, and died. A Catholic priest was also shot and wounded. Coleman was acquitted by an all-white jury. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. referred to Daniels' sacrifice as heroic.

August 15: St. Mary — Mother of Jesus. As a young Jewish girl, Mary gave birth to Jesus. She followed her son in his ministry right to the cross, and was active in the early church.

August 16: Brother Roger (Roger Schutz, 1915 – 2005) – founder of the Taizé Community, an ecumenical monastic community in France. Brother Roger was from Switzerland. In WW2, he and his sister hid Christians and Jews in danger from the Nazis. The Taizé religious community (with Roger as its first Prior) was formed in 1944 as a monastery for men living together in poverty and obedience, open to all Christians. The Taizé worship experience involves repetitive choruses (usually scripture verses) in many languages. There are shared moments of silence and candle lighting. Brother Roger would give short talks and lessons, but was not a fan of formal preaching. In 2005 he was stabbed to death by a mentally ill woman.

August 18: Mildred Mann (1904 – 1971) - Mildred Mann was mentored by Emmet Fox. New Thought author, Alan C. Anderson, studied with Mrs. Mann for many years. Mann became the founder of the Society of Religious Pragmatism, later reorganized as the Society of Pragmatic Mysticism. The teachings of the Society were based on the practice of the Presence of God in daily life.

August 19: Robert Watson Wood - Congregationalist minister who started advocating for LGBTQ rights in the early 1960s. He died Aug. 19, 2018, at age 95. In 1960 Wood's book, "Christ and the Homosexual" he urged churches to welcome gay and lesbian people. He picketed for Queer rights in 1965 protests and remained an LGBTQ advocate throughout his life.

August 20: St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090 – 1153) – Bernard was a French abbot who wrote homoerotic poetry about Jesus and had a passionate relationship with Irish archbishop Malachy of Armagh. The two were buried together.
