SOCIAL HALL HOSPITALITY RETURNS – Starting Sept 25 Social Hall Hospitality will be back! Just coffee and treats between 10 am and 10:30 am. This gives people leaving the first service and those coming to second service both a chance to have a little pick me up but also meet one another. There will also be a staff leader there for about 10 minutes to welcome everyone as well as our new Hospitality Host, Melody Fiore. If you're interested in helping Melody as a hospitality team member, just contact her or Rev. Kevin Tisdol. Another step toward post-pandemic normalcy.

HELP NEEDED – Summers traditionally hit us hard (financially) and this summer is no exception. This year we haven't had helpful pandemic relief grants and people haven't returned to church in full force yet (getting there, but slowly). Our summer club helped but not enough to last the whole summer. So, we need your help. To continue to operate at full steam, we are asking those who are behind in giving to catch up a bit, and for everyone who can to give a bit extra at least once. We don't want anyone to give more than they can, and we know that expenses are increasing for everyone. But if you can help, your generosity will be appreciated and put to good use. Thank you, as always, for your gifts of time, talent, treasure, and testimony. All of it helps us be who we are and do what we do.

BE CAREFUL – as life seems to return to something that looks more familiar, we should remember to guard our health carefully. With Covid, Meningitis, and Monkey Pox around these days, and the good old fashioned Cold and Flu season around the corner, please get vaccinated for everything possible (don't be afraid of medicine – God, being omnipresent, is in the medicine, and being

the source of wisdom, also inspires the sciences that bring us the medicine). Wash your hands often, and between washings, use hand sanitizer. Wear a mask if you ever feel uncomfortable being around people. Our 9 am service is our smaller service and provides room for greater distancing. And we are still not offering communion by intinction but we are each serving ourselves. These precautions are meant to keep us all healthy, so let's do what we can to stay well and active!

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

August 21: Georgia Harkness (1891-1974)—Theologian and social critic. Harkness was the first woman to teach in a mainline Protestant seminary in the USA. She was a theologian, pacifist and Christian socialist. She demanded economic justice for all people, opposed racism, and supported ordination for women.

August 23: Harvey S. Hardman (1878 - 1966) – was the founder of The Mental Science Institute and School of Philosophy and was one of the lead ministers of First Church of Divine Science in Denver.

August 24: Apostle Bartholomew – one of "the Twelve." He may also be known as "Nathanael" in the 4th Gospel.

Simone Weil (1909-1943)—Philosopher and mystic. Born in France to a well-educated, nonreligious Jewish family, Weil had a brilliant mind and was drawn to philosophy. She dabbled in the labor movement and always identified with the suffering masses of humanity.

Bayard Rustin (1912 – 1987) - African American leader in social movements for civil rights, socialism, nonviolence, and gay rights. Rustin was an organizer of the March on Washington, organized "Freedom Rides" and helped to start the Southern Christian Leadership Conference. Rustin was a gay man and in the 1980s became a public advocate of LGBT rights. He also championed workers' rights. Posthumously, Rustin was praised by President Reagan and awarded the Medal of Freedom by President Obama. Rustin was Quaker and his personal spirituality was a combination of Quaker pacifism, Gandhi inspired non-violent protest against injustice, and socialistic approaches to socio-economic problems.

August 25: St. Genesius the Comedian (d. circa 300) – St. Genesius is the patron saint of actors, comics, dancers, clowns, and torture victims. According to legend, he performed a series of plays that mocked Christians. During one performance for the Emperor Diocletian where he was making fun of baptism, he had a vision of angels and converted to Christianity right on stage! At first the Emperor thought it was part of the humor, but after he realized the comedic actor was suddenly serious, he ordered him to renounce his instantly embraced faith. For refusing to comply with the Emperor's order, Genesius was beheaded.

August 27: Simeon Bachos (first century CE) – The Ethiopian Eunuch who interacted with the Deacon Philip (Acts 8), a high ranking official in the court of the Ethiopian Queen, is considered by many Queer theologians and hermeneuticists to be a Queer figure (gay or non-binary by today's understandings). He was baptized by Philip. Since the late 2nd century this Ethiopian Eunuch has been known as Simeon Bachos. In 2022 he became a saint in the Episcopal Church.
