



They will remain part of our Global Fellowship and will return occasionally to visit friends and family in Florida. We send them off with love, and also with gratitude for all that they have meant to the life of this Cathedral and to many of us personally. God bless the diva and the techie and their kids!

ANNUAL FALL HARVEST CAMPAIGN BEGINS – Every year we ask people to put aside one dollar a day for 99 days so that we can each give \$99 above and beyond our usual giving the Sunday before Thanksgiving. This always helps us recover from slow summers and, along with the winter holiday extravaganzas, helps us end the year in the Black. This year, because of so many things going on at once, we are a bit delayed kicking off the campaign. Now, putting aside a dollar a day will mean a gift of \$84 on Harvest Sunday (we'll receive it with deep gratitude), but we can also add a "tip" if we wish and give the traditional \$99 anyway. Whatever you give is always appreciated and put to good use. Start putting aside a dollar a day for Sunshine Cathedral, and remember, a \$15 tip at the end won't hurt anything.

SOCIAL HALL HOSPITALITY RETURNS – Starting Sept 25 Social Hall Hospitality will be back! Just coffee and treats between 10 am and 10:30 am. This gives people leaving the first service and those coming to second service both a chance to have a little pick me up but also meet one another. There will also be a staff leader there for about 10 minutes to welcome everyone as well as our new Hospitality Host, Melody Fiore. If you're interested in helping Melody as a hospitality team member, just contact her or Rev. Kevin Tisdol. Another step toward post-pandemic normalcy.

BE CAREFUL – as life seems to return to something that looks more familiar, we should remember to guard our health carefully. With Covid, Meningitis, and Monkey Pox around these days, and the good old fashioned Cold and Flu season around the corner, please get vaccinated for everything possible (don't be afraid of medicine – God, being omnipresent, is in the medicine, and being the source of wisdom, also inspires the sciences that bring us the medicine). Wash your hands often, and between

washings, use hand sanitizer. Wear a mask if you ever feel uncomfortable being around people. Our 9 am service is our smaller service and provides room for greater distancing. And we are still not offering communion by intinction but we are each serving ourselves. These precautions are meant to keep us all healthy, so let's do what we can to stay well and active!

HELP NEEDED – It is unusual to make an extra ask while announcing another campaign (e.g. The Fall Harvest Campaign), but the situation warrants this extra ask. Summers traditionally hit us hard (financially) and this summer is no exception. This year we haven't had helpful pandemic relief grants and people haven't returned to church in full force yet (getting there, but slowly). Our summer club helped but not enough to last the whole summer. Performances which help us financially have been cancelled for a variety of reasons (a couple for Covid – it's still around). Our investments usually provide the church with an addition \$5k in dividends each quarter, but the third quarter of this year we received nothing from that account (the market was nobody's friend that quarter). And, we've had low offerings for a few consecutive weeks.

These various setbacks have added up and we need your help. To continue to operate at full steam, we are asking those who are behind in giving to catch up a bit, and for everyone who can to give a bit extra at least once. We don't want anyone to give more than they can, and we know that expenses are increasing for everyone. But if you can help, your generosity will be appreciated and put to good use. For us to ask in this way does let you know how urgent the situation is becoming. Thank you, as always, for your gifts of time, talent, treasure, and testimony. All of it helps us be who we are and do what we do.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

August 30: Louise Hay (1926 – 2017) – Louise had a difficult start to life. She was abused as a child, dropped out of high school, became a model and married a successful business man, but 14 years later they divorced. It wasn't until she was in her 40s that she discovered the Science of Mind philosophy and studied to become first a Religious Science Practitioner and then a minister. She survived cancer and became a writer, painter, motivational speaker, and publisher. Love, forgiveness, and affirmations were her trademark tools for healing and transformation. Her career as a spiritual leader lasted almost 50 years wherein, she gave people hope and courage to face the difficulties in life. At the outbreak of the AIDS crisis, she started "The Hayride", a popular support group for people diagnosed with a disease that at that time had no treatment. After a long and fascinating life, Louise made her transition about two months before her 91st birthday.

August 31: Aidan of Lindisfarne (590-651) - Irish monk credited with restoring Christianity to Northumbria. He founded a cathedral on the island of Lindisfarne and served as its first bishop. He is known as the Apostle of Northumbria.

September 1: Socrates (469 – 399 BCE) - believed in the mind/body connection. He said, "One ought not to attempt to cure the body without the soul." He also believed in the continuity of life beyond the death of the body. Rather than focusing on the Greek gods of his time, Socrates believed in tending to an "Inner Voice." He was executed (by poison), but said, "You can kill my body, but you cannot kill me." The story of a noble teacher who is executed but who cannot stay dead is also found, of course, in the Christian gospels!

Plato (427 – 347 BCE) - taught that there was a definite energy that emerged out of the cosmic nothingness of "mind." He suggested that this energy was the product of thought and it resulted in ideas which precede manifest form. In fact, Plato believed ideas were the source of life, purpose, and meaning. He believed souls (self-aware consciousness) pre-existed before their human incarnation and that they came to this life with prior knowledge. He believed that everything existed in relation to its resemblance to a Universal Form.

Aristotle (384 – 322 BCE) - believed the universe is governed by [spiritual] law. He defined God as "the first cause and the final cause of all being." Believing in the perfection of God, Aristotle also believed that everything in the world aspires to share in that divine perfection.

Philo (circa 20 BCE – 50 CE) taught that it is our duty to offer love and kindness towards others. He seemed to be able to harmonize Plato's philosophy with teachings of the Hebrew scriptures. He often read the scriptures allegorically rather than literally. He believed that God directs all activity through the Logos (the power of Ideas, Reason, Wisdom).

September 2: Emma Curtis Hopkins (1849 – 1925) - a student of Mary Baker Eddy's and for a time an editor for the Christian Science Journal, Emma and Mrs. Eddy eventually had a parting of the ways. Emma started her own seminary in Chicago and taught students who would become the greats of New Thought, including: Helen Wilmans, Myrtle and Charles Fillmore, a Mrs. Bingham (who introduced metaphysical healing to the Brooks sisters), Annie Rix Militiz, and briefly late in her life, Ernest Holmes. Because of her influence over the founders of so many New Thought groups, ECH is often called, "the Teacher of Teachers."

Helen Brungardt (1931 – 1998) – a New Thought minister with training in and connections to Rosicrucian spirituality, the Science of Mind, Unity, Kriya Yoga (Center of Spiritual Awareness), and Divine Science. She was the minister of Symphony of Life Church in Corrales, New Mexico and a member of the International New Thought Alliance.

September 3: Samuel Checote (d. 1884)—Creek Chief and preacher. Checote was born in present-day Alabama and attended mission schools as a child. After the Creek nation was forced to move west of the Mississippi tensions led to the banning of Christian preaching. Checote refused to abandon his faith and interceded with the chief to lift the ban. A Creek Methodist district was established. Checote became a lay preacher, and worked to have the bible and many hymns translated into Creek. He was elected chief three times, and worked tirelessly to overcome racial and cultural differences.
