WEDNESDAY NIGHT RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Education at Sunshine Cathedral is fun and transformative. Be part of it! Since Aug 31 we've been offering Midweek Reading & Reflection on Wednesdays at 7 pm on Facebook. It's 10-20 minutes of a reading and thoughts on the message of the reading. The readings come from contemporary and ancient poets, scriptures of the world traditions, and writings of spiritual teachers. The LAST Midweek Reading and Reflection on Facebook will be presented on Nov. 23.

THEN, we begin an on-site bible study at Sunshine Cathedral Square: Nov. 30, Dec 7, Dev 14, and Dec 21 we will be featuring Drag Bible Story Hour. This is a legit, in depth, transformative educational experience. It is simply being offered by a theologian in drag. It will be fun and fierce and not to be missed!

THEN, in the New Year, we will continue midweek bible study (sans the drag) and we will call the new series Bible and Beer. It will be at the church at 7 pm and led by the senior minister. We will have refreshments (including beer)...no admission, no collection plate, no selling...just come for bible study and pick up a beverage to enjoy (there will almost certainly be a tip jar for love offerings).

Wednesday night religious education is well established and will continue, but the format continues to evolve.

Nov. 16 and Nov. 23 are the last two Facebook Midweek Reading and Reflection times.

Nov. 30 - Dec. 21 we will have Drag Bible Story Hour at Sunshine Cathedral.

Starting in January 2023 (be watching for exact date), we launch Bible and Beer.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

November 20: Helen Zagat (1893 – 1975) – Helen Zagat is the author of the classic text, Faith & Works. A graduate of Barnard College and a former modern dancer, she became a Divine Science minister and was the pastor of the Church of Divine Unity in NYC. Her ministry spanned more than 30 years. She wrote, "In our awareness of God as Omnipresence, we feel that Spirit cares for each one of us. We are never alone." She stressed 5 attributes of God: Life, Wisdom, Love, Power, & Substance.

November 21: Nichiren Daishonin (1222 – 1282) - a Japanese Buddhist monk who taught that serenity, happiness, well-being, and enlightenment were available to everyone and could simply be attained through mantra meditation. The mantra he offered was "Nam Myoho Renge Kyo" (referring to a Buddhist text which Nichiren believed contained all that was needed for enlightenment. The text was believed to be so powerfully true that simply chanting its title would impart its benefits). Nichiren Buddhism is now a major Buddhist school of thought.

Quentin Crisp (1908 - 1999) - known for both wit and style, Crisp worked briefly as a "rent boy" and for decades as a model for art colleges. Crisp wrote articles, plays, and books, including The Naked Civil Servant, Becoming a Virgin, and Resident Alien. Quentin Crisp played Queen Elizabeth I in the film Orlando (and appeared in well over a dozen films). Crisp performed on stage with Penny Arcade and starred in a solo show for many years in the UK and in the US. At 72, Crisp moved from the UK to the US and resided in NYC for 18 years. Quentin identified throughout their life as gay, but at age 90 (shortly before dying) accepted and shared that they were transgender. In a Q&A session of a show in LA, Quentin shared this profound theology: "If God is the unifying factor, if God is the cell within the cell, the universe that encompasses the universe - then I would accept prayer and I would accept the idea of God. Don't forget, almost all religions move toward the unifying factor, the God behind God, the God of Gods..."

November 23: Walatta Petros (1592 – 1642) - Ethiopian nun who had a lifelong friendship with another nun and led a successful movement to drive out foreign missionaries. Walatta Petros is recognized as a saint by the Ethiopian Tewahedo Orthodox Church, which honors her for preserving early African Christian beliefs by expelling Portuguese Jesuit missionaries.

Clement of Alexandria (circa 150 CE – 215 CE) - had a capacity for blending Christian Thought, Platonism, and Stoic philosophy. His thinking contributed to Christian Gnosticism. Clement believed that faith, knowledge, and love were needed for a full experience of the Realm of God.

November 24: Baruch Spinoza (1632 – 1677) - born in Amsterdam because his father had been exiled from Portugal. He was a student of the Jewish Talmud and the

Torah, as well as of Kabala. Spinoza was also influenced by Maimonides and Descartes. A pantheist, he believed God to be the very Substance of the Universe. He also challenged people to think in abstract ways, saying, "God is not only the process of thinking, God is also the thought itself."

November 25: C. Alan Anderson (1930 - 2012) - a Process New Thought philosopher, held a PhD in Philosophy from Boston University. His doctoral dissertation was titled, "Horatio W. Dresser and the Philosophy of New Thought." He developed what is believed to be the first New Thought website. He wrote God in a Nutshell, The Problem is God: The Selection & Care of Your Personal God, and with his wife (Dr. Deb Whitehouse), New Thought: An American Spirituality. November 26: Sojourner Truth (1797-1883)—Abolitionist preacher. Born a slave to a Dutch family in New York, Sojourner (a name she chose later in life) was freed when slavery there was abolished. She became noted as a passionate itinerant preacher and a legend even in her own life. She devoted her life to the antislavery cause, and later to women's suffrage and equal rights. While some thought it was best to set aside the rights of women for a later date, in her mind the two were inseparable.

A SORDID ADVENT - Join us on November 27 at 6 pm for a FREE showing of Sordid LIves.

In just the last couple of months the world has lost both Olivia Newton-John and Leslie Jordan, both of whom were in the cast of the film *Sordid Lives*.

To show this film at the beginning of Advent is meaningful because the first Sunday in Advent is dedicated to Hope and both Newton-John and Jordan offered hope throughout their careers. Dame Olivia Newton-John lived with cancer on and off for decades and survived two bouts of cancer before the third bout ended her life at 73.

In addition to being a living model of facing difficulties with hope and courage, she also worked to bring hope to Queer people as she was one of the first celebrities to advocate for marriage equality in Australia.

Leslie Jordan, who died at age 67, was a very "out" gay man who brought joy through comedy to people all over the world. He also brought comic relief to us in pandemic by taking to social media just to give us a few chuckles in lockdown.

Jordan frequently spoke about living in recovery. He would speak at Alcoholic Anonymous events to encourage large numbers of people seeking to remain in sobriety. Both Jordan and Newton-John played Queer characters in the film, Sordid Lives.

A gay man and a fierce straight ally, both of whom lived out loud to give people facing discrimination, illness, and addiction hope, were lost to us in 2022, but their work and their generosity live on. We happily begin our Season of Advent, on Hope Sunday, with a showing of Sordid Lives.
