In a jail cell in Birmingham, Alabama in 1963, Dr. King wrote, "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere. We are caught in an inescapable network of mutuality, tied in a single garment of destiny. Whatever affects one directly, affects all indirectly."

Accepting the Nobel Peace Prize in Oslo, Norway in 1964, Dr. King said, "I believe that unarmed truth and unconditional love will have the final word in reality. This is why right, temporarily defeated, is stronger than evil triumphant."

And at the National Cathedral in 1968, Dr. King said, "We shall overcome because the arc of the moral universe is long, but it bends toward justice."

MAKE-OVER CAMPAIGN – The Sunshine Cathedral Foundation did a soft launch of a new capital campaign last year and now it's time to amp it up. The SC Foundation manages legacy funds and capital campaigns to help assure the long term health of the Sunshine Cathedral

Square (and all that goes on at the Square). Building repairs, air conditioning, roofs, parking lots, investments, property insurance, our courtyard mural...all of this and more are handled by our completely volunteer Sunshine Cathedral Foundation Board of Governors. In times of crisis, the Foundation has also helped with operations, such as the first year of the COVID pandemic when the Foundation gave Cathedral ministries a monthly allowance to help us in that very uncertain time. We depend on the Sunshine Cathedral Foundation and we support the foundation primarily with estate planning and with capital campaigns. So, here we are.

We need to raise a little over \$300,000 to replace windows in the Administration building, to replace air conditioning, to improve our Global Fellowship outreach, to arrange for better food storage for our food sharing ministry, and to upgrade various kinds of equipment and property necessities. We can take 2-3 years to raise that amount, but we need to start now and if we can get most of that amount pledged in the next few months, we'll be well on our way. It's not an onerous amount if we all chip in. While we ask you to do all that you can, we never ask that you do more than you can. And all gifts are blessed with love and gratitude and put to good use. By taking care of our beautiful property we can continue to offer ministry to our local community and to our Global Fellowship. SAINTS OF THE WEEK

January 16: Phineas Quimby (1802 – 1866) - generally considered the father of the New Thought movement. He spoke of the "Christ Principle" and considered Jesus to be an inspired soul. He said that mind as matter and mind as invisible essence (or solution) are controlled by a Superior Wisdom, which Jesus understood. Long before Einstein discovered that energy and mass are equal, identical and interchangeable, Quimby was saying that mind as form and mind as solution (or essence) was the same thing. Quimby was known as a healer. He reasoned that dis-ease is really a belief and beliefs can be changed. To change the underlying thought is to change the condition.

January 17: Mary Oliver (1935 – 2019) – lesbian poet whose work expresses love for nature, compassion for humanity, and subtle references to Queer intimacy.

January 18: Gladys Alberta Bentley (August 12, 1907 – January 18, 1960) - an American blues singer, pianist, and entertainer during the Harlem Renaissance. Gladys was lesbian, preferred men's suits to what was considered women's attire, and right before her death became an ordained minister.

January 19: H. B. Jeffery (1872 – 1954) - Studied with Malinda E. Cramer, Emma Curtis Hopkins and Thomas Troward. He worked with Emma Curtis Hopkins on High Mysticism, and taught courses based on Hopkins' work. His own books include Spirit of Prayer, Fruit of the Spirit, and Coordination. Jeffery taught, "God is the One Good. Thus goodwill is the Will of God manifest in [us]."

January 20: St. Sebastian (d. 288) – victimized by the persecutions of the Emperor Diocletian. Sebastian was "executed" by arrows, but somehow survived and was miraculously healed by a woman named Irene. When the newly revived Sebastian went to the emperor to confront him (feeling, apparently, immortal after his last brush with death), the emperor had him beaten to death on the spot. In art, Sebastian is often depicted as beautiful, athletic, nearly nude, pierced by arrows, taking joy in his faithfulness but also suffering agony because of his mistreatment. Gay men often identify with the paintings of Sebastian and relate the picture to their own life experiences.

January 21: St. Agnes (d. 304?)— Traditionally, a young teenager from a wealthy Roman family who refused to marry or to worship non-Christian deities. She was condemned first to brothel, and then to death.
