**LENT** – We are in the Season of Lent, the time of preparation leading to Easter. Some "fast" during Lent (skipping one meal or day or giving up something enjoyable like sweets) but at Sunshine Cathedral, we encourage rather than literal fasting that we "give up" things like self-criticism, religious based fear, unkind attitudes toward others, selfishness, greed, etc. We also encourage "taking on" (or renewing) positive practices, such as daily prayer, generous giving, weekly worship, and supporting worthy projects. These weeks of spiritual practices leading to Easter can serve as a time of renewal for our faith lives. We hope you will actively engage in Lent this year and that your Lenten journey will lead you to Easter joy.

**COMMUNITY HERO AWARD** - A Progressive Queer Church and the local Salvation Army wouldn't normally form alliances. But during Pandemic, the local Salvation Army post needed help keeping their pantries stocked in order to feed those who were food insecure. They put out a call to other ministries in the county to help them if possible, and Sunshine Cathedral was the one that answered the call. In addition to our own food sharing ministry, we've been sharing food with the local S.A. ever since.

That's why the Salvation Army of Broward County awarded Sunshine Cathedral the Community Hero of the Year Award. Both the Salvation Army and the Sunshine Cathedral agree that no one should suffer from hunger. We are thankful to the Salvation Army of Broward for this lovely award and for the opportunity to confront food insecurity with them.

The Salvation Army is one of almost 40 ministry partners we work with to provide food, wellness support, personal empowerment, and advocacy to people in our community and far beyond.

**MAUNDY THURSDAY** – On April 6 at 7 pm there will be a Maundy Thursday service in the Lawrence/Lewis Center for Worship & the Arts (the worship center). It will be about half an hour in length. It's a special Communion service to commemorate the Last Supper. We will also reflect on the life of Jesus as depicted in our Chancel Windows! A brief and reflective service, this is a beautiful way to begin the Triduum (the final three days of Lent).

**GOOD FRIDAY** – Join us at 7 pm on April 7 (Good Friday) for a musical event. Our Good Friday service of music and readings is also dramatic and powerful. Save the date and plan to be with us on Good Friday.

**EASTER** – Eastertide is 49 days and begins on Easter Sunday. Join us at 9 am or 10:30 am on Easter Sunday for worship. This will prove to be an amazing celebration.

#### SAINTS OF THE WEEK

March 14: Fannie Lou Hamer (1917-1977)—Prophet of freedom. Raised in a family of sharecroppers in rural Mississippi, Hamer rose up as a prophet to challenge the oppression of segregation and poverty. At the age of 45 she attended a civil rights rally and committed herself to the freedom movement. On several occasions she was arrested and beaten, but despite the dogs, fire hoses, clubs, and bombs she drew on her deep faith and vision of justice to challenge the powers of oppression. She died of breast cancer.

March 15: St. Longinus – Longinus is the name tradition gives to the unnamed Roman soldier who pierced Jesus' sided with a spear during the Crucifixion. Tradition also holds that he became a follower of the way of Jesus.

March 16: Grant Lynn Ford (1939 – 2019) – Pentecostal Minister, Independent Catholic Bishop, Metropolitan Community Churches (MCC) Pastor, and Divine Science Minister. Bishop Ford had a talent for blending high church liturgy, charismatic enthusiasm, and New Thought teaching into a unified experience of celebration. He pastored

the Sunshine Cathedral in Fort Lauderdale 22 years before retiring. He was succeeded by his hand-picked replacement, Rev. Dr. Durrell Watkins, another religious pluralist/liturgist/New Thought practitioner. Grant was a graduate of a Pentecostal bible college and a life-member of the International New Thought Alliance and held an honorary doctorate from Light University (later known as The Samaritan Institute). Sunshine Cathedral's Grant Lynn Ford Prayer Garden is named for him.

March 17: St. Patrick (389-461)—Bishop and missionary of Ireland. He was born into a Christian family in late Roman Britain. At 16 he was captured by Irish raiders and taken into slavery, where his only consolation was his Christian faith. Years later he escaped and returned to England, where he eventually became a Bishop. He felt called back to Ireland where he was able to spread the Christian faith.

Anne Kunath (1932 - 2021) - If you know about Divine Science, you are probably aware of some Divine Science luminaries, such as Malinda Cramer (the movement's founder), Nona Brooks (a secondary founder and primary leader after Malinda's death), Fannie James (Nona's sister and the systematic theologian of the early movement), Emmet Fox (writer and speaker - his NYC congregation was the largest religious audience under one roof in the US during the Great Depression), Irwin Gregg (one of the founders of the Divine Science Federation), and Joseph Murphy (writer of The Power of Your Subconscious Mind). Another name should be added to this list of spiritual giants: Anne Kunath.

Anne had been mentored by famous New Thought teacher Catherine Ponder. Anne Kunath was also a founder in her own right. In 1998 she founded the United Divine Science Ministry School (she also led a church in San Antonio). She named her ministry "United Divine Science" to "unite" the teachings of the various founders (Cramer and the Brooks sisters). The Brooks' branch of Divine Science had become dominant and Anne wanted to renew awareness and interest in the original founder, Malinda Cramer.

UDS eventually joined the Divine Science Federation and the ministry school would later be led by Rev. Dr. Christopher Bazemore.

Divine Science was founded by women and the work to renew interest in its original founder was spearheaded by a woman, Anne Kunath.

March 18: Eberhard Bethge (1909 – 2000) - German theologian and pastor, best known for being the close friend and biographer of the theologian and Dietrich Bonhoeffer. Bethge was a member of the German anti-Nazi Resistance, but was drafted into the German army. He was later arrested, along with dozens of other resisters, after a failed attempt to kill Hitler on July 20, 1944, but he was rescued by Soviet troops shortly before his scheduled trial. It appears to some that Bethge's friendship with Bonhoeffer may been romantic in nature.
