

LENT – We are in the Season of Lent, the time of preparation leading to Easter. Some "fast" during Lent (skipping one meal or day or giving up something enjoyable like sweets) but at Sunshine Cathedral, we encourage rather than literal fasting that we "give up" things like self-criticism, religious based fear, unkind attitudes toward others, selfishness, greed, etc. We also encourage "taking on" (or renewing) positive practices, such as daily prayer, generous giving, weekly worship, and supporting worthy projects. These weeks of spiritual practices leading to Easter can serve as a time of renewal for our faith lives. We hope you will actively engage in Lent this year and that your Lenten journey will lead you to Easter joy.

MAUNDY THURSDAY – On April 6 at 7 pm there will be a Maundy Thursday service in the Lawrence/Lewis Center

for Worship & the Arts (the worship center). It will be about half an hour in length. It's a special Communion service to commemorate the Last Supper. We will also reflect on the life of Jesus as depicted in our Chancel Windows! A brief and reflective service, this is a beautiful way to begin the Triduum (the final three days of Lent).

GOOD FRIDAY – Join us at 7 pm on April 7 (Good Friday) for a musical event. Our Good Friday service of music and readings is also dramatic and powerful. Save the date and plan to be with us on Good Friday.

EASTER – Join us at 9 am or 10:30 am on Easter Sunday for worship. This will prove to be an amazing celebration.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

March 19: St. Joseph — Little is known about Joseph, apart from the Nativity stories in Matthew and Luke. He is pictured as a person of deep faith, open to mystical experiences, who had great compassion. As a carpenter he is known as the patron saint of working folk. His family home was said to be in Nazareth.

March 20: John Boswell (1947 – 1994) - a Yale history professor who wrote about LGBTQ people in church history. His two most well-known books are: Christianity, Social Tolerance, and Homosexuality; and, Same-Sex Unions in Premodern Europe. He died at age 47 from AIDS-related complications. He joined the Roman Catholic Church as a teenager and attended mass daily until he died even though he disagreed with Catholic official positions on homosexuality.

March 21: James Joseph Reeb (1927 - 1965) - minister and civil rights activist. Reed earned degrees from St. Olaf College, Princeton Theological Seminary, and Conwell School of Theology. He began his ministry as a Presbyterian hospital chaplain, but later resigned his credentials to become a Unitarian minister because he was impressed with the social justice focus of the more liberal religious tradition. In his new role he served as a YMCA youth director and later served as Assistant Minister of DC's All Souls Church. Later he would move to Boston to work with the Metropolitan Housing Program focusing on desegregation. He participated in the Selma to Montgomery marches in 1965 where he was murdered by white segregationists. Three men were tried for his murder but were acquitted by an all-white jury. Reeb was married with 4 children and was only 38 years old when he was killed. President Johnson called his widow and Dr. King eulogized him at Brown Chapel in Selma.

March 24: Archangel Gabriel – a messenger in sacred literature. Gabriel appears to Daniel in the Hebrew scriptures and to both Mary and Zechariah in the New Testament. Gabriel is also mentioned in the Book of Enoch as well as in the traditions of Islam and the Baha'i Faith.

St. (Archbishop) Oscar Romero (1917-1980)—Martyr of El

Salvador. As the violence of the death squads escalated Romero experienced a personal transformation as the voice of the poor and a fearless champion of justice. He was unafraid to confront the political, military, and even religious forces of oppression. The masses of poor found in him a shepherd who loved them. He was assassinated at the altar while saying Mass in a hospital.

March 25: The Annunciation to Mary, the Blessed Lady — Luke tells the story (1:26-38) of the visit of an angel to announce to a young Jewish girl that she would give birth to the messiah. The Church, from its very beginning, has given Mary a place of honor for being the mother of Jesus.

Ted Jennings (1942 – 2020) - a Chicago Theological Seminary professor who wrote books affirming Queer people the bible. He was an ordained Methodist minister who spent more than two decades teaching at Chicago Theological Seminary. He retired in 2017 as Professor Emeritus of Biblical and Constructive Theology. His books include: "The Man Jesus Loved: Homoerotic Narratives from the New Testament" and "Jacob's Wound: Homoerotic Narrative in the Literature of Ancient Israel". At CTS, Jennings initiated the Gay Studies program, which grew into the Center for LGBTQ Religious Studies.
