

AN EASTER PRAYER – by Rev Dr Durrell Watkins

Lord Jesus, in whose memory and spirit we now pray, we rejoice that life is everlasting, hope cannot be kept down, joy will not stay dead, and love can never be killed.

Stories of your life, death, and unending presence beyond death give us inspiration and comfort and strength. Your light could not be dimmed. We, in your name and for your sake, will let our light shine brightly today.

The words of the poet Maya Angelou ring in our hearts: 'You may shoot me with your words, you may cut me with your eyes, you may kill me with your hatefulness, but still, like air, I'll rise.'

With you, Anointed One, we rise with wings of love on winds of joy, and we celebrate the indomitable power of life. Alleluia. Alleluia. Amen.

AN EASTER REFLECTION – by Sophia Fahs, religious educator

The people who followed Jesus were brokenhearted after he died. They struggled to understand why God had allowed their teacher to be killed. Surely someone so connected to God, so overflowing in goodness, did not deserve the punishment of a criminal or rebel. As these men and women gathered day after day in each other's homes, they began to recall the wonderful experiences they had had with Jesus. They told one another of times when Jesus was wise, and times when Jesus was kind. The very tone of Jesus' voice and the look on his face would come back to them so vividly that it seemed, sometimes, as though Jesus were again right there with them.

Some of the people had dreams in which Jesus seemed so real that the dreamers could not tell whether they had been asleep or awake when they saw him. Some declared positively that they had seen Jesus again. He had talked with them! The rumor spread that Jesus had actually come out of his coffin, that two of his disciples had seen him, and that several of the women had talked with him; they

would see him only for a few moments, and then he would mysteriously disappear again.

Finally, several of them [imagined] they saw Jesus rise up from the earth—higher and higher—until he disappeared entirely. They believed he had gone to heaven to be with God. And after that, their dreams of seeing him and talking with him stopped.

People who had these experiences believed that Jesus was different from other people. Some believed that Jesus was so holy and great that he would come back to earth and save the world...

The years passed by. The people who knew Jesus died. Their children and their children's children also died. But Jesus did not come back... There are those who still hope he will come back...

Others...believe that this Jesus' ...body is not coming back; but, his spirit never needs to die. His spirit is in his words and deeds which still give us wisdom today. For example, when he was alive, Jesus taught The Golden Rule: Treat others the way you want to be treated. Jesus gave the Sermon on the Mount, where he said that people who are poor, hurt, and struggling are loved by God and therefore, we must love them, too.

When someone's physical body dies, the people around them who loved and valued them will keep their memory alive—just like the followers of Jesus have remembered his teachings and his spirit, long after his death.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

April 9: Dietrich Bonhoeffer (1906-1945)—Theologian and martyr. Bonhoeffer was deeply committed to the ideals of Christian community. He helped organize resistance to the Nazi takeover of German churches. When the Confessing Church movement was snuffed out he was imprisoned for his participation in the plot to kill Hitler. Influenced by the Social Gospel movement in America, he later wrote in prison of the need for a "religionless Christianity." His writings have been a major influence on Christian Ethics in our time. Some have speculated that Bonhoeffer's well-known affection for his dear friend Eberhard Behge suggests a possible gay orientation.

James Dillet Freeman (1912-2003) – the "Poet Laureate" of the Unity School of Christianity. He composed the prayer: "The Light of God surrounds us; the love of God enfolds us. The power of God protects us; the presence of God watches over us. Wherever we are, God is!" Not only is that prayer used in the Sunshine Cathedral liturgy (and in New Thought centers everywhere), it was taken to the moon in 1969!

April 10: Kahlil Gibran (1883 – 1931) - was born in Ottoman Syria (now Lebanon) and was the grandson of a Maronite Catholic priest. The Gibran family moved from the Middle East to Boston (USA) where he flourished as a poet, artist, and philosopher. He later studied in Paris and lived in NYC where he wrote and painted. His most famous work is *The Prophet*. His writings were very popular in the counter-cultural movement of the 1960s. Here are some of

his inspiring words: "All that spirits desire, spirits attain", "An eye for an eye, and the whole world would be blind", "Beauty is eternity gazing at itself in a mirror", "Faith is a knowledge within the heart, beyond the reach of proof", and "I existed from all eternity and, behold, I am here; and I shall exist till the end of time, for my being has no end."

Pierre Teilhard de Chardin (1881-1955)—Mystic and scientist. A French Jesuit priest, Teilhard was both one of the most creative theological minds of the 20th century and an imminent scientist. He did extensive work in geology and paleontology in China, helping to discover the remains of "Peking Man." He sought to develop a synthesis of science and religion, integrating the theory of evolution with a cosmic vision of Christ at the heart of the cosmos. His writings, seminal to the development of Process Theology, were suppressed by the Vatican during his lifetime.

Howard Thurman (1899 – 1981) American author, theologian, and civil rights leader. He embraced a theology of radical non-violence. Thurman was a leading figure in 20th century social justice movements. He was a mentor to civil rights leaders, including Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Of his many books, *Jesus and the Disinherited* may be the most beloved. Thurman was Dean of Rankin Chapel (Howard University) for 12 years and then Dean of Marsh Chapel (Boston University) for another dozen years. Thurman co-founded, along with Alfred Fisk, the first major interracial, interdenominational church in the United States. *Ebony Magazine* called Thurman one of the 50 most important figures in African American history, and *Life Magazine* called him one of the 12 most important religious leaders in the U.S.

April 12: William Dorsey Swann - born into slavery, Swann became the first American to lead a queer resistance group and the first to self-identify as a "queen of drag." He fought back against police who raided a drag ball in 1888 almost a century before the Stonewall uprising. The event is considered one of the first examples of physical resistance for LGBTQ rights.

Swann also made history in 1896 when he requested a pardon from President Grover Cleveland for holding a drag ball. The request was denied, but it was an historic attempt to take legal action to defend the LGBTQ community.

April 13: Frederick Bailes (1889-1970) - Was a medical student from New Zealand. He had to drop out of medical school because he was diagnosed with diabetes (at the time considered to be untreatable). He found the writings of Thomas Troward and with the help of spiritual principles, found himself cured of his diabetes. He returned to medical school. He found that encouraging his patients made a noticeable difference in their recovery. He went on to become a Religious Science minister and writer. His books include *Your Mind Can Heal You* and *Hidden Power for Human Problems*. He wrote, "Our world will change as our ideas concerning ourselves change. So never be afraid to think highly of your value."

Ruth Hammink Carr (1909 – 2008) – raised in Unity, Ruth was ordained a Divine Science minister and served as the Assistant minister of the Divine Science Church of Birmingham, MI. She lived a few days past her 99th birthday and was active in her church until the end.

April 14: Origen (185-254) - a theologian in the early church. He taught universal salvation (no one is ultimately rejected by God). He believed that any idea of eternal damnation was unworthy of a good God, the God Jesus knew and shared. He thought only an insane deity would punish someone for all eternity, and he did not believe God to be insane. He allowed for biblical literalism for those "at that level" of understanding, but encouraged people to seek "higher" understandings of scripture.

April 15: Sallye Taylor (1940 – 2015) – Unity minister (ordained 1979) and renown bible teacher.
