SAINTS OF THE WEEK

September 10: Grace L. Faus (1897 – 1988) – founded the first Divine Science churches to operate in Washington, D.C. Ordained in 1934, she retired from pastoral ministry in 1969 but continued to teach religious courses from her home in Colorado.

September 11: Ss. Protus & Hyacinth (d. 258) - were the eunuch slaves who were the companions of St. Eugenia of Alexandria (lived as a man and became an abbot). They served as her teachers and ministry companions. A few months before Alexandria was executed, Protus and Hyancith were beheaded. As eunuchs, they were a sexual minority. Tradition calls them brothers, but that could be euphemism (or a type of closet for protection) for "couple."

Mychal Judge (1933 - 2011) - was a Franciscan priest serving as a chaplain to the NYC Fire Department. Serving in that capacity, he was the first certified fatality of the 9/11/01 terrorist attack on the U.S. He was ministering to the wounded and the dead when he himself was killed by flying debris. Judge was a gay man.

Walter C. Righter (1923 – 2011) – a graduate of Berkeley Divinity School, Righter served as an Episcopal priest for 2 decades in parishes in Pennsylvania and New Hampshire. For 16 years, Righter was the Bishop of Iowa. After he retired as a diocesan bishop, Righter spent 2 years as an Assisting Bishop in the Diocese of Newark (New Jersey) where John Shelby Spong was the Diocesan Bishop. In his role as Assisting Bishop, Righter ordained a gay man, Barry Stopfel, to the diaconate. For this, Righter was

charged with heresy by 10 fellow bishops (with 25% of all active bishops at the time registering support for the charge). A canonical court dismissed the charges (by a 7-1 vote) saying that the Episcopal Church didn't have a "doctrine" forbidding the ordination of gays, so the act wasn't heretical. Afterward, Bishop Righter wrote a book, A Pilgrim's Way, reflecting on his life and ministry, including the heresy trial.

September 12: Holy Name of Mary - In Hebrew, the name Mary is "Miryam". In Aramaic the language probably spoken by Mary and Jesus, the form of the name was "Mariam". Based on the root "merur", the name signifies "bitterness". This is reflected in the words of Naomi, who, after losing a husband and two sons lamented, " "Do not call me Naomi ('Sweet'). Call me Mara ('Bitter'), for ... my life [is] very bitter." Jerome suggested the Mary could mean "Lady", based on the Aramaic "mar" meaning "Lord." The name of Mary is venerated because it belongs to the mother of Jesus.

September 15: Martyrs of Birmingham (d. 1963) —Four young girls. A few weeks after Martin Luther King has given his famous speech, "I Have a Dream," and in the midst of an intense summer of civil disobedience and demonstrations, the situation in Birmingham, Alabama had come to a head. The nation watched as fire hoses and attack dogs had dramatized the evil of racism. On a peaceful Sunday morning someone threw dynamite through the basement window of the 16th Street Baptist Church, where four young African American girls, who had just finished their Sunday School class, were changing into choir robes. In their eulogy Dr. King called them "martyred heroines of a holy crusade for freedom and human dignity."

September 17: St. Hildegard of Bingen (1098-1179) — Abbess and visionary. Hildegard started as a simple Benedictine nun, but excelled as an author, prophet, preacher, theologian, musician, composer, poet, doctor, and pharmacist. Her intense visions and ecological and holistic spirituality speak strongly to our own time.
