Sunshine Cathedral: Blended Worship, Blended Spiritualities by Rev. Dr. Durrell Watkins (Senior Minister)

What people quickly notice about Sunshine Cathedral is our blended worship. We aren't tied to a single worship book, hymnal, or liturgical tradition.

There are always readings from the bible, but often, readings also come from other religious sources (A Course in Miracles, the Tao te Ching, Gnostic Gospels, the Bhagavad Gita, Sufi poets, etc.) as well as from secular sources (quotes from philosophers or social scientists or contemporary poetry, etc.).

Sermons usually involve exegesis and exposition of biblical texts, but often also include stories from world myths, from the Talmud, or even from contemporary super-hero narratives.

In a typical service you may hear gospel, classical, jazz, Broadway, and pop music as well the occasional Country & Western song or grand old Protestant hymn from Charles Wesley, Martin Luther, or Fanny Crosby.

We wear liturgical vestments, but from a variety of traditions, and we are Eucharistic, but the meaning of the Eucharist is unique to each communicant and the focus of the Eucharist is love and spiritual unity.

Prayers (sometimes with a bit of adaptation) will be recognized from Buddhism, monotheistic Hinduism, Judaism, Anglican prayer books, Roman Catholic practices, and New Thought metaphysics.

And the theology presented can be boiled down to God is the power and presence of love, and that presence is omnipresent, everywhere, fully present. Every single message you hear at Sunshine Cathedral will feature that simple but powerful and life-changing idea: God is omnipresent Love.

Just as our worship is a blend of many ideas, experiences, and traditions, so also is our theology the product of blending.

We are historically affiliated with Metropolitan Community Churches, a movement started by a gay, defrocked Pentecostal minister (Troy Perry) with a primary outreach to LGBTQ+ people and an enthusiastic affirmation of LGBTQ+ people as children of God designed to be exactly who they are.

We are also affiliated with the International Council of Community Churches, the Divine Science Federation, and the International New Thought Alliance.

For decades, we have embraced the principles of Progressive Christianity, the principles of New Thought, and the openness of spiritual humanism.

Progressive Christianity simply says questions are more important than the answers we come up with, that everyone is loved by God, that other religions also have wisdom and holiness, that science is important and not at odds with spirituality, and that scripture can be understood in a variety of ways and the best ways are those that promote justice, tolerance, goodwill, and peace.

New Thought began as an American healing movement in the 19th century. Their guiding principles were the omnipresence and goodness of God, the power of thoughts, feelings, and attitudes to help shape our experiences in life, and the use of affirmations and visualization to make prayer more effective.

Four Sunshine Cathedral clergy (including the senior minister) are ordained in Divine Science (founded by Malinda Cramer in 1888), one of the oldest of the New Thought ministries, and in the past another Divine Science minister and at least 3 Unity ministers (Unity is also a New Thought/positive Christianity movement) have also been on staff.

Finally, spiritual humanism is also part of the air we breathe at Sunshine Cathedral. Spiritual humanism affirms the innate goodness and the potential of human-beings, allows for spiritual community, spiritual experiences, and a variety of opinions about the existence and nature of divinity.

Examples of spiritual humanists include Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., the Roman philosopher Marcus Aurelius, or the founder of Reconstructionist Judaism, Mordecai Kaplan. Spiritual humanists, while not being limited by dogma or creeds, value the individual spiritual experience and the insights that come from it and also value evidence based science.

Blended worship and blended spiritualities – no wonder so many people with different backgrounds and different experiences find a home at Sunshine Cathedral. We are a blend of many ideas and practices making something new and exciting and inclusive. This experiment in blending results in a unique and joyous community celebrating and sharing this message: You are God's miracle and not God's mistake.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

September 24: Uell Stanley (U.S.) Andersen (1917 – 1986) – self-help and inspirational writer. Andersen believed that the physical world is derived from the mental. He believed that a sustained mental image, backed by faith, would become real in the realm of experience. His writings include Three Magic Words and The Magic in Your Mind. Anderson taught: "Everything which you can conceive and accept is yours! Entertain no doubt. Refuse to accept worry or hurry or fear. That which knows and does everything is inside you and harkens to the slightest whisper." He was influenced by the writings of Mary Baker Eddy, Emmanuel Swedenborg, and Edgar Cayce.

St. Anna Alexander (circa 1865 – September 24, 1947) - was the first and only African-American consecrated a Deaconess in the Episcopal Church. She served in the Episcopal Diocese of Georgia during her entire career, and may be remembered in the Calendar of saints on September 24. Non-clerical deaconesses were known from the time of the early Church through the 13th century and experienced a revival in the 18th and early 20th centuries and should not be confused with ordained deacons (whether women or men).

September 25: Virginia Ramey Mollenkott – self-described as Queer and Bi-Gender, Mollenkott was a literary scholar who also became well known as a Queer, Feminist, and Trans* theologies scholar. Her books include, "Is the Homosexual My Neighbor?" and "Omnigender." She also was a translator for the NIV version of the bible and served on the Inclusive Language Lectionary Committee

for the National Council of Churches. She died in 2020 at the age of 88.

September 27: St. Vincent de Paul (1580-1660)— Apostle to the poor. Vincent began his life as a priest simply as a means of escaping his family's grinding poverty. At mid-life he experienced a great transformation as he understood the seriousness of his vocation and dedicated his life to serving the poor. He founded hospitals, orphanages, and homes for the mentally ill.

Aimee Semple McPherson (1890 – 1944) – a Canadian born evangelist and radio personality in the 1920s and 1930s who was also the founder of the Foursquare Church, a Pentecostal denomination. She was a pioneer in the use of entertainment media to create a form of religious instruction and worship that appealed to a broad audience.

September 28: St. Wenceslaus (907-935) - Wenceslaus I was duke of Bohemia (and subject of a famous Christmas carol). The carol is based on a legend about Wenceslaus and his page Podiven. According to the story, on a miserably cold night they went out to give alms to the poor on the Feast of St. Stephen, Dec. 26. Podiven was walking barefooted and his feet were freezing, so Wenceslas told him to step in his foot prints. His footprints in the snow stayed miraculously warm, giving comfort to Podivan. According queer religious historian Kittridge Cherry, "The earliest accounts of Wenceslaus' life mention his page -- but not the woman who supposedly gave birth to his son in more recent versions. An account written in the late 10th or early 11th century describes the young man who was a... "chamber valet" to Wenceslaus. The duke was assassinated in a coup by his brother.

September 29: St. Michael and All Angels—While angels (from the Greek word angelos, or messengers) are mentioned often in the bible, only a few are named. The Archangel Michael is described as the captain of the heavenly host who helps humanity in fighting the powers of destruction and injustice. Michael has been recognized as a protector, intercessor, healer, and guardian.

September 30: Rumi (1207 – 1273) – Sufi poet from Afghanistan inspired by the love of a mentor and friend (their relationship may have been romantic as well). When his "friend", Shams, left for Damascus without telling him, Rumi was heartbroken and poured his feelings into his poetry. They were later reunited, but eventually, Shams disappeared again. This time it was believed he may have been murdered. Rumi continued to pour himself into his writing, using homoerotic imagery and romantic phrasing as he pondered things divine. He also practiced meditative dancing which inspired the Whirling Dervish movement. After grieving the loss of Shams, Rumi would love other men.
