A Story from the Torah (Numbers 22.22-29, 31-33)
Rev Dr Durrell Watkins

[Balaam was hired by the King of Moab to curse Moab's enemies. God told Balaam to not take the job, but he did anyway]. God's anger was kindled because he was going, and the angel of the Lord took a stand in the road as Balaam's adversary. As Balaam was riding on the donkey... the donkey saw the angel standing in the road, with a drawn sword; so the donkey turned off the road, and went into the field; and Balaam struck the donkey, to turn it back onto the road.

Then the angel stood in a narrow path between the vineyards, with a wall on either side. When the donkey saw the angel, it scraped against the wall, and scraped Balaam's foot against the wall; so he struck it again.

Then the angel of the Lord went ahead, and stood in a narrow place, where there was no way to turn either to the right or to the left. When the donkey saw the angel again, it lay down under Balaam; and Balaam's anger was kindled, and he struck the donkey with his staff. We did not follow cleverly devised myths when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we had been eyewitnesses of his majesty. For he received divine honor and glory when that voice was conveyed to him by the Majestic Glory, saying, "This is the one I love, with whom I am well pleased." SAINTS OF THE WEEK

July 9: Augustus Tolton (1854-1897) —First African-American Catholic priest. Tolton was born to Catholic slave parents who escaped during the Civil War. From an early age he felt a call to the priesthood. He studied in Illinois, and later in Rome, before being returned to the US to be ordained and work with struggling Black Catholic congregations. Though frequently marginalized by the establishment, he exposed racism in the church and worked for integration and equality.

July 11: Agnes Galer (1860-1939) —ordained a Divine Science minister by New Thought pioneer Nona Brooks (c. 1907) and established a church in Seattle. Galer is known for being the minister who ordained Ernest Holmes (Holmes was a Divine Science minister before starting the Religious Science movement).

July 12: H. Emilie Cady (1848 – 1941) – author of spiritual texts, including Lessons in Truth, one of the most widely read books in New Thought spirituality. She was a homeopathic physician. In one of her books she declared, "I AM"...is God's name...I AM cannot be weary, or faint, or powerless; for I AM is all-life, all-power, All-Good...'I AM' spoken upward, toward the good, the true, is sure to out-picture in visible good, in success, in happiness."

July 13: Frida Kahlo (July 6, 1907 – July 13, 1954) - bisexual Mexican painter. She is known for her selfportraits.

July 14: Kathleen Besly (1858 – 1946) – Divine Science minister who wrote the classic, The Divine Art of Living, in which she writes, "We cannot fear anything or anybody if we have the full realization that God is everywhere, that God is Love and that Love is the great power of life."

Sally Miller Gearhart (April 15, 1931 - July 14, 2021) -LGBTQ-rights activist (with Harvey Milk) and first "out" lesbian to receive a U.S. tenure-track faculty position (San Francisco State University 1973).
