What's It All About?

by Rev. Dr. Durrell Watkins (Senior Minister, Sunshine Cathedral)

On a recent episode of the Queer God Squad, our panel discussion program on Happening Out Television Network, the clergy panel responded to the question, "What is the purpose of life?" That's an age-old question, but the answer is simpler than we tend to make it. Life is for living. Live. Live well. Make the most of the current moment. Life is made up of moments. If the present moment is beautiful, then life is beautiful. Live this moment... Purpose fulfilled.

Rabbi Harold Kushner wrote: "When we stop searching for the Great Answer, the Immortal Deed which will give our lives ongoing meaning, and instead concentrate on filling our individual days with moments that gratify us, then we will find the only possible answer to the question, 'What is life about?'... It is about loving and being loved. It is about enjoying your food and sitting in the sun rather than rushing through lunch and hurrying back to the office. It is about savoring the beauty of the moments that don't last, the sunsets... the rare moments of true human connection. It is about savoring them rather than missing out on them..."

Alan Watts put it this way: "The meaning of life is just to be alive."

The purpose of life is to live. And when we live in love, we'll enjoy more of those precious, fleeting, moments. We're here to live and to love. Let's get on with it.

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

May 6: Henry David Thoreau (1817-1862)—Naturalist and social critic. While his writings were largely ignored in his lifetime, Thoreau's thoughts on social justice, freedom, and civil disobedience were to later influence Tolstoy, Gandhi, and Martin Luther King. A fiercely independent nonconformist, he followed no particular religion, but has been described as something of a Taoist sage. Some historians speculate that Thoreau may have been gay.

May 8: Blessed Julian of Norwich (1342-1416)—Mystic. Few details are known of the life of Dame Julian, a recluse who was famed as a spiritual counselor. She is best known for writing Revelations of Love Divine, the first book written in English by a woman. At the age of 30 she became gravely ill, but recovered following a series of visions of Christ. She spoke of God as our Creator, Protector, and Lover, and wrote of the motherhood of both God and of Jesus, emphasizing the goodness of creation and God's mercy toward the weak. She is often called "Blessed" even though she was never formally beatified.

May 10: Ida B. Elliott (1862 – 1957) – Divine Science founder Malinda Elliott Cramer's niece. Ordained by Nona Brooks (the originator of the Divine Science
